Conservative firebrand and Michigan Republican Senate candidate John James took the highly unusual move of comparing himself to Barack Obama's father in one of his few TV ads for the upcoming Nov. 6 midterm elections. "I'm a second-generation American," James said in the ad, as he stood on a split screen with Obama's father, Barack Obama Sr. The father pointed to his son and said, "I used to know a man like that." James was referring to the controversial Chicago-born Obama, Sr., a community activist and civil rights leader who was born in Kenya but was also educated in the United States. The ad is part of a new "Jobs, Jobs, Jobs" campaign for James, which he is spending over \$2 million of his own money to air in the final weeks of the election. The super PAC, "Women for Common Sense," is also putting up the money for the ad, according to Federal Election Commission records.

James' campaign says the new ad is similar to the one Barack Obama Sr. made for him in 2010 when he was running for a Senate seat in Illinois. "In fact, Barack Obama Sr. recognized John James as one of the country's next leaders, and he used to know a man like that," the ad's narrator says in the 30-second ad. The spot then shows footage of James and Obama Sr. shaking hands at a meeting to discuss community issues. "All these people are going to be living in your community and they're going to be depending on you to figure out what their needs are," James says, as he looks at Obama Sr. in the video. The Republican's campaign has blasted the Obama comparisons as "desperate," and supporters of James have launched an online petition to stop them from running. The barrage of ads comes at the end of a month of robo-calls and text messages to voters threatening an Obama presidency, claiming the campaign is a way for him to give out government benefits. The calls and texts say that if voters do not want to see Obama policies "forcing this country to 82157476af
